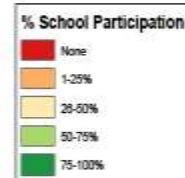
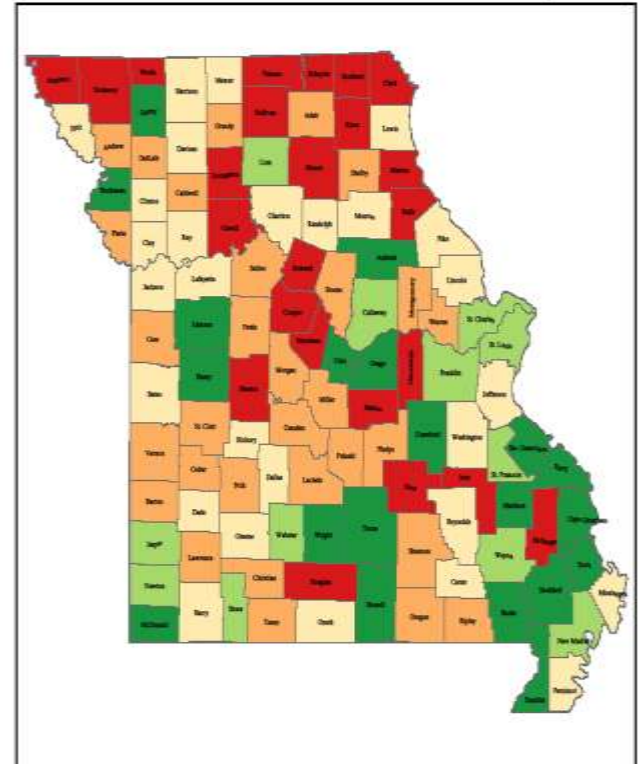

Great Central U.S. ShakeOut School Participation



Percentage of school participation was calculated by summarizing the reported number of participants in the ShakeOut by county, and dividing by the total annual school enrollment provided by DESE. Note that the values for St. Louis County and St. Louis City were combined due to data location reporting inaccuracies.

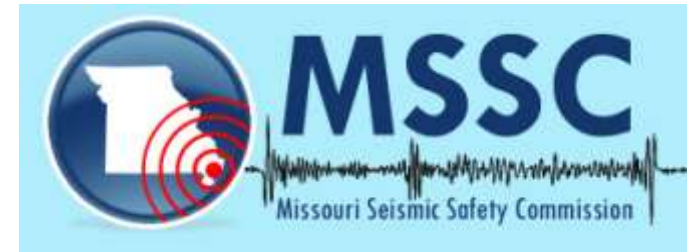
